In 2025, Grace Place continued strengthening our Digital Center, expanding our online ecosystem to guide women and families directly to our website to schedule appointments and access care. Visitors now see a clearer overview of our services, as well as immediate support options, including our fully integrated 24/7 nurse hotline, which has become a lifeline for clients in moments of crisis but also operates as a directory for plugging clients into the most reasonable and convenient care for their specific needs. A part of these efforts has also included expanding bilingual services to ensure comprehensive care no matter the situation.

These digital advancements have significantly increased our reach, allowing Grace Place to connect with more women considering abortion and meet them with truth, compassion, and the hope of Christ. Through these efforts, we have been able to connect with thousands of people in need. In the Four Corners Region, but also in 4 surrounding states.

Our team maintains consistent follow-up with clients after their appointments, and we rejoice that 97% continue to choose life for their babies.

Meanwhile, our parenting program remains a cornerstone of long-term support, equipping moms and dads with practical tools, mentoring relationships, and a pathway toward the abundant life found in Christ alone.

IVY'S STORY

When my husband and I first came to Grace Place, we were newly married and still finding our footing. Life felt exciting but also overwhelming. Finances were tight, and since we no longer qualified for Medicaid, even getting a simple pregnancy test felt out of reach. I had started feeling those early signs of morning sickness and knew I needed answers. That's when my cousin Jessica told me about Grace Place. She had been a faithful client, and I already admired the ministry and the way my church celebrated every time a mom chose life. Hearing her experience made the decision easy, we knew we needed to go.

Walking into Grace Place for the first time, I remember being struck by how genuinely welcoming everyone was. They didn't just greet us; they truly cared about what we were facing. My husband, Jesse, came with me, and they made sure he felt included from the moment we stepped in. They even gave him a bracelet that said, "Dads Matter," and he still wears it today. Hearing our baby's heartbeat for the first time was an unforgettable moment. In that season of financial stress and uncertainty, that sound gave us hope and reminded us we weren't walking this road alone.

As the months passed, I began attending their parenting classes. I quickly realized how much I still had to learn as a new mom. One lesson that changed everything for me was the "three-minute rule," giving my son three minutes of undivided attention every time we reunite. It sounds simple, but it transformed our connection. The classes also offered practical tools for everyday life and reminded me to stay teachable, even when I felt confident. Being on one income has been challenging, and the diapers, wipes, clothes, and food that Grace Place provides have truly helped, but the wisdom and encouragement I've gained have been even more valuable.

Jesse works long hours as a truck driver and can't attend the classes, but I always share what I learn with him. When our first child was born, he was able to take a month off work, giving us precious time together as a new family. We even traveled to Texas when our baby was just two weeks old to visit his mom. It wasn't easy, but it became one of my favorite early memories, introducing our little one to his grandma and feeling our family bond strengthen. Now, as we prepare to welcome our second son, we feel more confident and equipped than ever.

Grace Place has become so much more than a health center to me. They welcomed us warmly, supported us through challenges, and celebrated with us in moments of joy. When I look at my family now, I can see God's hand in every detail. Life hasn't been easy, but in the hard places, He has written a story of hope, redemption, and new beginnings, and Grace Place has been a meaningful part of that journey.

Their ministry is also deeply personal to me because of my own past. When I was fourteen, my innocence was taken from me, and the pregnancy that followed came from an experience that was forced on me. At first, I believed adoption was my only option, but as the baby grew, so did my bond with him. I kept him for a year before realizing I wasn't ready. Placing him with a family was one of the hardest decisions of my life, and even now, I sometimes ache knowing my children don't know their brother. Still, what matters most is that he was given the chance to live, something many in similar situations are never offered.

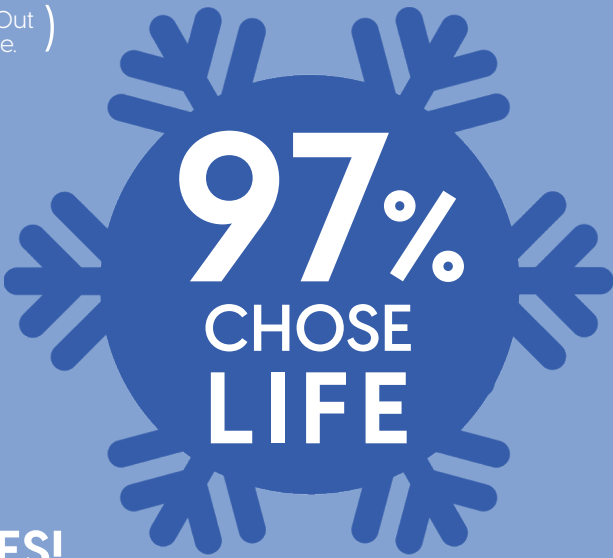
